Parking: Park in short term lot and enter terminal through the Baggage Claim Entrance Parking will be validated for interviewees <u>Global Entry</u> is a U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) program that allows expedited clearance for pre-approved, low-risk travelers upon arrival in the United States. Members enter the United States through automatic kiosks.

Terminal Expansion Project


Construction updates as of Dec. 2021






